Re: Tobacco Compliance Checks

On March 10, 2010, the Police Department conducted tobacco compliance checks on all of our licensed businesses within the City. All of the businesses passed, with the exception of the BP gas station, located on Aquila Drive. Although the owner of the Champlin BP had just purchased the station six days prior to the compliance check, he had his thirteen year old son working behind the counter. The son sold cigarettes to the 17 year old decoy.

Attached is the Officer Narrative, the Ordinance Violation letter that was issued to the Champlin BP along with a copy of the City's Tobacco Ordinance for your information.

The owner of the gas station has requested the Tobacco Compliance Hearing to tell his side of the story and request that the City have sympathy on the \$500 fine, as he had only been open for six days and his son was just helping out while he was on Spring Break.
