

2010 Champlin Police Citizen's Academy

The Champlin Police Department will be hosting its annual Champlin Police Citizen's Academy beginning March 18th. This is a free six-week course that provides citizens with a better understanding of the Champlin Police Department. It is designed to form a partnership between police and the community.

Sometimes the only perception of law enforcement we receive is from what we see on television, which is the Hollywood version. This course will provide an honest approach to law enforcement and the various organizations which help support the Champlin Police Department.

Throughout the six weeks, numerous guest speakers with different areas of expertise will present on such topics as Criminal Investigation, the Hennepin County Medical Examiner's Office, DWI Laws, Traffic Enforcement, Tactical Use of Force, K-9 and X26 Tasers. The course will include a tour of the newly expanded Champlin Police Department and the Hennepin County Sheriff's Dispatch Center in Golden Valley. Course participants also have the opportunity to experience a Firearms Training Simulator lab (F.A.T.S). This simulator trains officers how to maintain control in high pressure shoot/no shoot situations.

The course begins March 18th and ends April 22nd. We meet Thursday nights from 7:00 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. at the Champlin Police Department, located at 11955 Champlin Drive.
