- City Staff Attending: City Administrator Bret Heitkamp, City Clerk Roberta Colotti and City Attorney Darrell Jensen.
- Approval of Agenda Motion by Councilmember Johnson and seconded by Councilmember Whalen to approve the agenda for the March 8, 2010 Executive Session as presented. Voting in favor: Mayor Uglem, Councilmembers Nelson, Johnson and Whalen. Voting against: none, whereupon said motion passed this 8th day of March, 2010.
- Employee Contract
Negotiations The City Administrator stated that he has reached a tentative agreement with the AFSCME employees for 2010. He stated that if acceptable to the City Council the AFSCME contract would be brought back for formal action by the City Council on March 22nd.
