- Call to Order The Champlin City Council met in Executive Session and was called to order by Mayor Mark Uglem at 9:01 p.m. to discuss labor contract negotiations and condemnation hearing proceedings.
- Roll Call Present were Mayor Mark Uglem, Councilmembers Eric Johnson, Julia Whalen, Greg Payer and ArMand Nelson.
- Excused Absent: none.
- City Staff Attending: City Administrator Bret Heitkamp and City Attorney Darrell Jensen.
- Approval of Agenda Motion by Councilmember Johnson and seconded by Councilmember Payer to approve the agenda for the April 12, 2010 Executive Session as presented. Voting in favor: Mayor Uglem, Councilmembers Nelson, Johnson, Payer and Whalen. Voting against: none, whereupon said motion passed this 12th day of April 2010.
- Employee Contract
Negotiations The City Administrator updated the City Council on the status of the contract negotiations with the AFSCME employee group.
- Council Consensus**
After a lengthy discussion, the City Council directed the City Administrator to pursue a multi-year contract agreement, requesting a commitment from AFSCME to assist the City in getting through these two extremely difficult economic years of 2010 and 2011, with the understanding that the Council would reciprocate the commitment to the employees in 2012.
- Chapman Condemnation
Hearing The City Attorney updated the City Council on the Chapman condemnation hearing.
- Council Consensus**
The City Council provided staff and legal counsel with the parameters associated with a proposed negotiated settlement offer that was to be presented, prior to the hearing commencing on April 13th.
- Adjourn The Champlin City Council adjourned the Executive Session at 9:45 p.m.
