ROAD CLOSURE

Residents who live between Chandler Park and Shores Park, north of West River Road, will be allowed to cross on Pennsylvania Avenue at the discretion of the Champlin Police Department. Kentucky Circle residents should be sure to park their vehicles at Shores Park, north of Kentucky Circle. This is the only exit for this area. The Anderson Estates Addition will be allowed to cross at Hampshire Avenue. They will then be required to follow Mississippi Drive to the south, to Welcome Avenue to access West River Road.

There will be no parking in the Champlin Community Service Center area, but there will be free and ample parking at the Champlin Plaza.

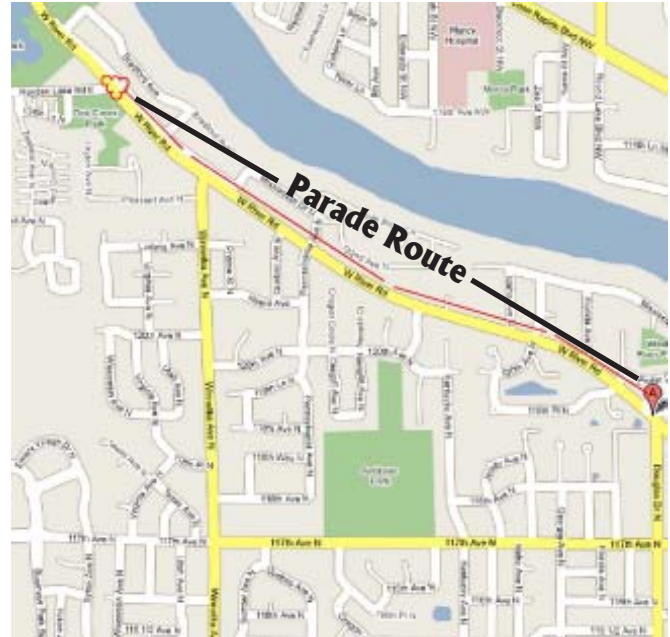
