

Champlin Environmental Resources Commission Application

The Champlin City Council welcomes your application to serve on the Environmental Resources Commission (ERC). The Commission is the City's advisory commission on environmental matters including refuse and recycling management.

The Commission is made up of nine members. Members are appointed as representatives of one of the City's four wards. Members of the Commission are appointed by the Mayor with majority consent of the City Council for terms of three years, except any person appointed to fill a vacancy occurring prior to the expiration of term to which his or her predecessor was appointed shall be appointed only for the remainder of such term.

Commission meetings are held monthly on the first Monday of the Month at 7 p.m. with Work Session meetings scheduled prior to the regular meeting time as needed.

Applications are accepted throughout the year. The Commission serves voluntarily without pay.
