To participate in the annual curbside collection of used appliances, you must purchase a sticker from the City for \$12 per appliance by Tuesday, May 16th. Then place the sticker on your appliance and set it out by your garage before 7:00 a.m. on May 22nd.

It's requested that you place the appliance by garage vs. at the curb. The company making collections is A1 Appliance if an unauthorized person comes to collect your appliance please call 911 as there are scrappers that will take the appliance strip out the valuable parts and improperly disposal of remaining elements. Collection will not start before 7 a.m. on May 22nd.

City Hall is located at 11955 Champlin Drive and is open from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. Phone: 763-421-8100.

Appliances must be in a non-compacted condition. They must not contain food, debris, or other foreign material.

The recycler retains the right to refuse any appliances deemed to be in such a compacted or destroyed condition which prevents the proper removal of hazardous wastes and/or refrigerants according to law.

Accepted Appliances Include:

- Washers
- Dryers
- Stoves
- Refrigerators
- Freezers
- Dishwashers
- Microwaves
- Air Conditioners (Any Size)
- Water Heaters
- Dehumidifiers
- Humidifiers
- Water Softeners

A1 Appliance is the contracted vendor for the City's event. If you are not able to participate in this year's event but are in need of appliance disposal services you can contact them directly for drop-off/collection services and prices.
