Paper Shredding

No Charge

Maximum of six grocery bags/three bankers boxes of material.

Electronics

20 cents per pound

All types of electronics including computers, cell phones, land line phones, calculators, printers and more.

Bicycles

No Charge

The Re-Cycle bike shop will be collecting bicycles in any condition. Many of the bikes will be restored and returned to the road for re-use. Others will be stripped for parts.

Scrap Metal

No Charge

Used scrap metal including grills, swing sets, gutters and eaves, door and window frames, tire rims, etc. (All glass, rubber, etc. must be removed).

Tires

\$3 per tire

Only car and light truck passenger vehicle tires are accepted.

Small Engines

No Charge

Lawnmowers, chainsaws, snow blowers, ice augers, go-karts, snowmobile, etc.

You do not need to separate the engine from the equipment. You do not need to drain the oil and gas.
