- Call to Order The Champlin City Council met in Worksession and was called to order by Mayor Ryan Karasek at 5:30 p.m.
- Roll Call Present were Mayor Ryan Karasek, Councilmembers Jessica Tesdall (Ward 1), Eric Johnson (Ward 2), Nate Truesdell (Ward 3) and Ryan Sabas (Ward 4).
- Absent: None.
- Also Present: City Administrator Bret Heitkamp, Community Development Director John Cox, City Engineer Tim Hanson, City Clerk Roberta Colotti, and City Attorney Scott Lepak.
- Approval of Agenda Motion by Councilmember Johnson and seconded by Councilmember Truesdell to approve the agenda (February 13, 2017) for the February 13, 2017 Worksession as presented. Voting in favor were Mayor Karasek, Councilmembers Tesdall, Johnson, Truesdell, and Sabas.

- 2017 Street Improvement The City Engineer stated that on October 24, 2016 the City Council adopted a resolution "Directing the Project Preparation of Plans and Specifications and Ordering the 2017 Street Improvements, Improvement Project No. 21603". He stated that Plan Approval and Authorization to Advertise for Bids is anticipated to be on the February 27, 2017 City Council agenda. As a result he wanted to take this opportunity to provide an overview of the project and answer any questions of the new City Councilmembers.
- The City Council discussed the street lighting policy as it relates to the distance between lights and locating lights on the same side of the street or alternating them from side to side. It was noted that Bradford Avenue has a significant number of trees making it a dark street.
- The City Engineer stated that he would further study the street lighting plan for Bradford Avenue in consideration of the extensive tree cover and provide a recommendation at a future meeting.
- The City Administrator reviewed the assessment policy as it relates to neighboring cities.
- The City Engineer reviewed the construction timeline, noting that work will be scheduled to address the needs for parking and road access during Father Hennepin Festival.
- Adjournment The Champlin City Council adjourned the Worksession at 6:17 p.m.
