- Call to Order The Champlin City Council met in Worksession and was called to order by Mayor ArMand Nelson at 6:30 p.m.
- Roll Call Present were Mayor ArMand Nelson and Councilmembers Eric Johnson, Ryan Karasek, Bruce Miller and Kara Terry (arrived at 6:51 p.m.).
- Absent: None.
- Also present were City Administrator Bret Heitkamp, Community Development Director John Cox, and City Clerk Roberta Colotti.
- Approval of Agenda Motion by Councilmember Johnson and seconded by Councilmember Miller to approve the agenda for (September 12, 2016) the September 12, 2016 Work Session as presented. Voting in favor were Mayor Nelson, Motion Councilmembers Johnson, Karasek, and Miller. Voting against: none. Motion carried.
- Mississippi The City Administrator stated that staff had an opportunity to review the comments received at the Crossings/Commons: September 8th Public Information Meeting on the Mississippi Crossings/Commons development. He Review of Public reported that four project stations were presented at the meeting including information on the Comments the Crossings, Commons, Hwy. 169 Improvements and the Elm Creek Dam & Mill Pond. He stated that the meeting was well attended and that the comments received were generally very positive with the primary question being when each project element would move forward.
- He reviewed several of the comments and stated that staff is working on a formal report compiling the comments that were received at the Public Information Meeting and are continuing to be accepted at City Hall. He stated that a joint meeting between the City Council and Park and Recreation Commission will be schedule to review the report and discuss the next steps in the project development.
- The City Council discussed the comments as presented by the City Administrator and additional comments they received including those related to boat, canoe and jet ski access, dock specifications, boat trailer parking enforcement, alcohol in the parks, restaurant development schedule, future parking lot design, underpass design, and project funding.
- Adjournment The Champlin City Council adjourned the Work Session at 6:59 p.m.
