- Call to Order The Champlin City Council met in Worksession and was called to order by Mayor ArMand Nelson at 6:35 p.m.
- Roll Call Present were Mayor ArMand Nelson and Councilmembers Eric Johnson, Kara Terry, Ryan Karasek, and Bruce Miller.
- Absent: none.
- Staff Present: City Administrator Bret Heitkamp, Community Development Director John Cox, City Clerk Roberta Colotti, City Attorney David Schaps and City Council Candidate Ryan Sabas (Ward 4) .
- Approval of Agenda Motion by Councilmember Johnson and seconded by Councilmember Miller to approve the agenda for (October 24, 2016) the October 24, 2016 Worksession as presented. Voting in favor were Mayor Nelson, Councilmembers Motion Johnson, Terry, Miller and Karasek. Voting against: none. Motion carried.
- City Code Chapter 6 The Community Development Director presented a revised draft amendment to the City code governing Alcoholic Beverages alcoholic beverages based on the City Council direction provided at the September 26th Work Session. He stated that the draft ordinance provides for the addition of small brewers, taprooms, brew pubs and the Sunday sales of growlers, not currently allowed under City code. He noted that the proposed ordinance allows for six Off-Sale Liquor licenses. The City currently allows for four Off-Sale Liquor Licenses.
- The Community Development Director stated that when the City went through the most recent codification process it was advised at the time to remove the 300' set back from schools and churches that was previously in place based on case law at the time. He stated that while the state law has been amended to authorize the establishment of a set-back it is not recommended that a set-back be instituted with the new code.
- The Community Development Director stated that in 2017 staff will be reviewing the zoning ordinance in relation to the liquor ordinance and will bring forward any recommended changes at that time.
- The Community Development Director stated that a public Hearing and First Reading of the Ordinance Amending Chapter 6 Alcoholic Beverages and Chapter 22 Fees will be scheduled for November 14th with second reading/adoption scheduled for November 28th.
- Adjournment The Champlin City Council adjourned the Worksession at 6:43 p.m.
