Call to Order

The Champlin City Council met in Worksession and was called to order by Mayor Nelson at 7:30 p.m.

Approval of Agenda (January 26, 2015) Motion Motion by Councilmember Johnson and seconded by Councilmember Terry to approve the agenda for the January 26, 2015 Worksession II as presented. Voting in favor were Mayor Nelson, Councilmembers Karasek, Terry, Johnson and Miller. Voting against: none. Motion carried.

Alternative Land Uses: Hwy. 169 Corridor

The Community Development Director stated that previously, the City Council directed staff to consider and recommend potential alternative land uses for eleven undeveloped properties along the highway corridor. Tonight six of these properties are being presented for Council discussion. The balance will be introduced in February.

The Community Development Director stated that the six undeveloped highway properties were platted between 1997 and 2005 and are shovel ready. The staff review considered land uses other than their current commercial zoning including office warehouse, townhomes, apartments and auto related businesses.

Parcel No. 1

4-Acre Parcel South of Willy McCoy's Wiley Properties #30.120.21.12.0010-14

Council Consensus

It was the consensus of the Council to consider office warehouse for this site if a plan can be developed that blends with the existing adjacent residential community. Staff was directed to talk with the other adjacent property owner regarding combining the two parcels for development. Staff was directed to bring back sample drawings showing the proposed building types.

Parcel No. 2

1.49-Acre Parcel 122nd Avenue & Business Park Boulevard Hidden Oaks LLC #30.120.21.13.0007

Council Consensus

It was the consensus of the Council not to pursue residential development (i.e. detached townhomes) on this site. It was further the consensus of the Council to consider auto related uses such as high end detailing and car wash businesses. Auto repair and sales are not part of the list of auto related businesses envisioned for this site.

Parcel No. 3

1-Acre Parcel 121st Avenue & Business Park Boulevard Hidden Oaks LLC #30.120.21.13.0005

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Council Consensus

It was the consensus of the Council not to pursue the development of detached townhomes on this site and to make no other changes to the zoning for this site.

Parcel No. 4

.71-Acre Parcel 120th Avenue & Business Park Boulevard Ryan Companies US #30.120.21.42.0010

Council Consensus

It was the consensus of the Council not to consider alternative land uses for this site further, given its limited size.

Parcel No. 5

3.57-Acre Parcel Champlin Village Ryan Companies US #30-120.21-42.0007-0008 #30.120.21.42.0012

Council Consensus

It was the consensus of the Council to direct staff to further evaluate senior housing as an alternative land use for this site.

Parcel No. 6

4.4-Acre Parcel Emery Village Chesapeake Companies #30.120.21.43.0208

Council Consensus

It was the consensus of the Council not to consider alternative land uses for this site any further.
