

# Champlin Park and Recreation Commission Application

The Champlin City Council welcomes your application to serve on the Park and Recreation Commission. The Commission is the City's advisory commission on parks, recreation and trail related issues. The Commission is responsible for the review of park programs and policies and for making appropriate recommendations to the City Council.

The Commission is made up of nine members. Members are appointed as representatives of one of the City's four wards or as an at-large member. Members of the Commission are appointed by the Mayor with majority consent of the City Council for terms of three years, except any person appointed to fill a vacancy occurring prior to the expiration of term to which his or her predecessor was appointed shall be appointed only for the remainder of such term. The Commission serves voluntarily without pay.

Commission meetings are held monthly as determined by the Commission Chair and the Parks Facilities Manager. The current schedule is the first Tuesday of the Month at 7 p.m. with Work Session meetings scheduled prior to 7 p.m. on the same evening.

Applications are accepted throughout the year and appointments are made in January and as vacancies occur.
