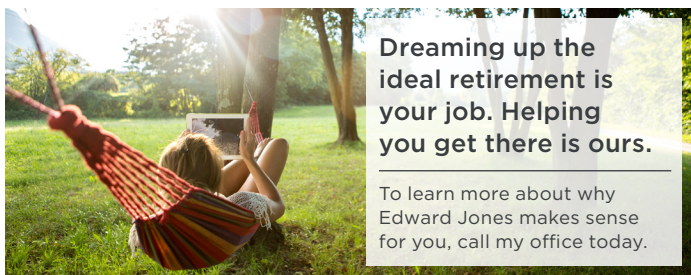

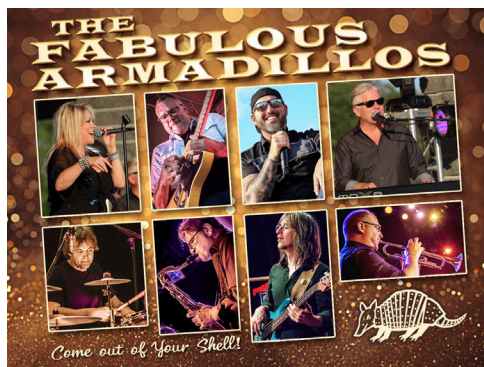

The Fabulous Armadillos came out of their shell in 2006 and have since established a large following in Central Minnesota with their spot-on music

ranging from country to Motown to heavy metal to 70s soft rock.

The idea of the Fabulous Armadillos started with a diverse group of musicians who came together to perform “themed” concerts at the Pioneer Place on Fifth Theater in St. Cloud, MN. Themes include “One Hit Wonders,” “Woodstock,” “Motown,” “Singer/Songwriters,” “Stadium Rock,” and more. They have played hundreds of themes at regional venues in the Midwest and even in Mexico! Each show gains new fans. They have brought hundreds of special guests in for their shows comprised of local and national talent.



### Anderson Daniels

Saturday, June 11 | 6 - 8 p.m.

Champlin native Anderson Daniels is on a straight path to creating a new Midwestern sound in country music. The 27-year-old musician takes pride in the blended sound that pulls from his roots. In 2018, Daniels released his first EP titled “Heartland,” which debuted inside the top 20 on the iTunes country charts.

After taking home the New Artist of the Year Award at the annual Midwest Country Music Association Award Show in 2019, followed by a nomination for Male Vocalist of the Year in 2020, Anderson has toured extensively throughout the nation opening for some of country music’s legends and rising stars. He recently released a brand-new single, “Way Out” in April of this year, followed by the album *Country & Midwestern: Side A* in May.

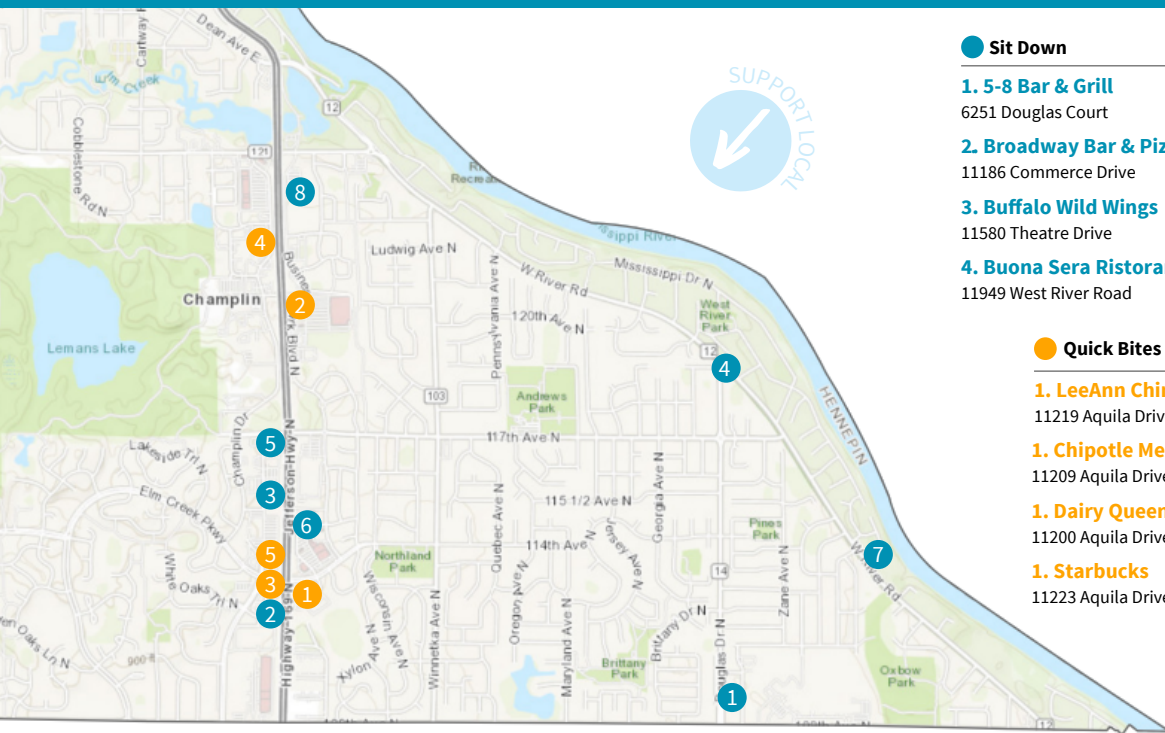

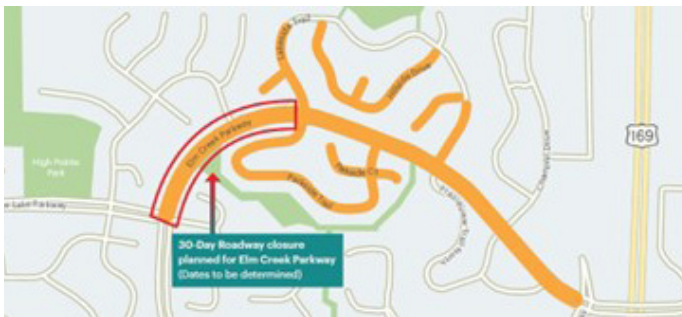


# Street and Utility Improvements

Summer projects are under way. Construction in the Lakeside Trail, Hillside Drive, and Parkside Trail neighborhoods is anticipated to be complete in July 2022. The work in general includes reconstruction, partial to full curb, sidewalk and trail replacement, improved pedestrian crossings, and utility improvements.

Along Elm Creek Parkway between Goose Lake Parkway and Jefferson Highway, reconstruction is anticipated to occur between July and September. Elm Creek Parkway will be reduced to one lane of traffic in each direction during the construction season. In addition, Elm Creek Parkway is anticipated to be closed between Goose Lake Parkway and Lakeside Trail/Parkside Trail (west entrance) for a 30-day consecutive period in July and August. Signs will be installed notifying drivers seven days in advance of the closure. A detour route will be provided and access to emergency vehicles will remain.

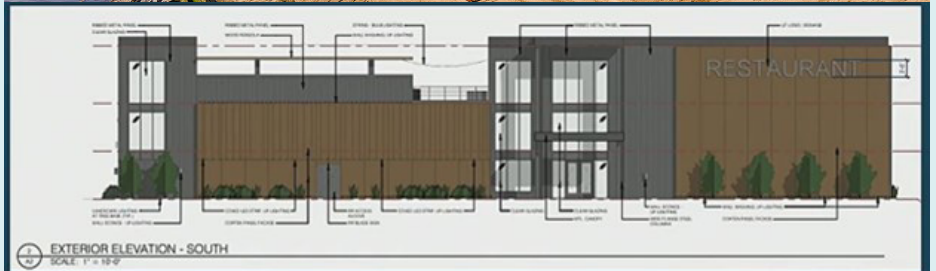

## What Does It Take To Be a Firefighter?

What used to be referred to as “volunteer” is now “paid on call professionals.” That’s right! Firefighters get compensated and undergo extensive training to complete the job professionally and safely. It’s much more than a few hours and just riding a firetruck. It’s a commitment like no other. It’s a way to give back and serve your community.

## Interested? Here are the requirements:

- 18 years and older
- High school diploma
- Live within 8 minutes from a station
- Pass a physical ability test, a psychological exam, a background check, and a doctor’s physical

Upon job offer, training begins for six months and a total of 164 hours in college-level classes to learn fire behavior, thermal dynamics, and tool operations to prep for the state exam and certification as Firefighter I and II. From there, you’ll earn our medical certifications in EMR or EMT and Apparatus Operations. Each class is 40 to 60 hours.

Whew, it is a lot! Once certifications are earned, every firefighter is required to attend continuing education. Therefore, the fire department is seen training regularly. In fact, the Anoka-Champlin Fire department has daytime and evening training three times a month. So, the next time you see us training on the river or practicing at an acquired structure, give us a wave and think about how much firefighters go through just to “volunteer!”

# Election Day 2022

## 5 Steps to Voting

### 1. KNOW THE DATES

- August 9, 2022 State Primary  
(absentee ballots available June 24)
- November 8, 2022 General Election  
(absentee ballots available Sept. 23)

### 2. REGISTER TO VOTE

- Check your status or register to vote on the Secretary of State's website:  
[sos.state.mn.us/elections-voting/register-to-vote](https://sos.state.mn.us/elections-voting/register-to-vote)

### 3. FIND YOUR POLL

- We completed redistricting, a process that happens once every ten years. The state redistricting process changed the boundary of state house districts 34A and 34B, resulting in Ward 4 in Champlin being split into two legislative districts. Your polling location may have changed, so check [pollfinder.sos.state.mn.us](https://pollfinder.sos.state.mn.us) before you vote. It is expected to be updated in July.

### 4. VIEW A SAMPLE BALLOT

- Available 46 days before each election.



### 5. VOTE

- In person or via absentee ballot request on the Secretary of State's website [sos.state.mn.us/elections](https://sos.state.mn.us/elections)

- Governor and Lieutenant Governor
- Secretary of State, Attorney General, and State Auditor
- State Senator
- State Representative
