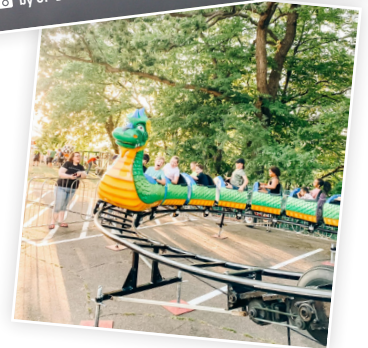

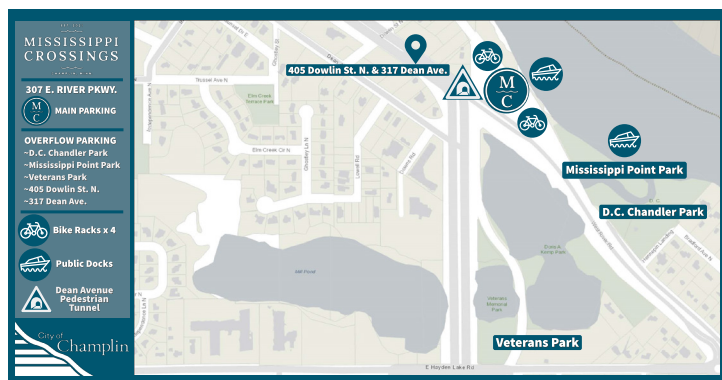

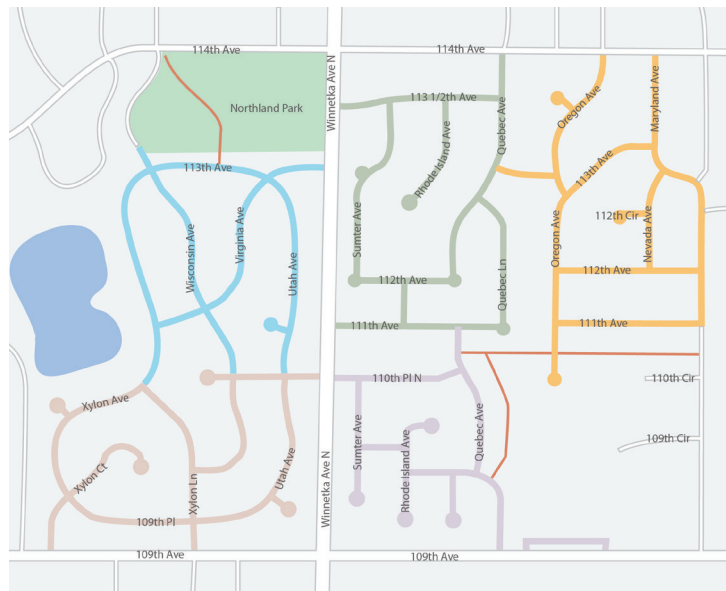
2023 Street Improvement Project

You may have noticed construction along Highway 169. There are two projects that began this spring – a new gymnastics facility for Twin City Twisters and four additional condominium buildings in the Emery Village neighborhood.

- **Twin City Twisters** is a gymnastics facility that has served our community since 1987. They officially broke ground on a 40,000 square foot building, just south of Willy McCoy's. The anticipated completion of construction is in early 2024.
- **The Emery Village** neighborhood is gaining new neighbors. The property south of Goodwill began construction in March of 2022 and anticipates completion later this year. This property contains four 10-unit condominium units and will complete the residential area of the Emery Village neighborhood.
