Dear Champlin Business Owner:

At their meeting on July 25, 2022, the Champlin City Council took action to approve an Interim Ordinance placing a 12-month moratorium on the sale, testing, manufacturing, and distribution of THC products. The attached ordinance imposes a one-year moratorium on the retail sale of THC-infused edibles and drinks within the City of Champlin. The purpose of the moratorium is to provide sufficient time for City staff to study the issues related to the potential sale of THC related product in the City.

In the event you are or have been selling, testing, manufacturing, or distributing THC-infused products in your business, you are hereby required to cease and desist immediately. A violation of this Ordinance is subject to the City's general penalty listed in Champlin City Code Sec. 1-7 (copy attached). The City may also initiate any legal action deemed necessary to secure compliance with this Ordinance.
