
Review and Discussion of
Concept Land Use Plans
for the Greater Mississippi
Crossings Small Area
Study The City Planner stated that the City of Champlin, in partnership with the Hennepin County Planning Grant, is continuing the development of a Small Area Plan for the Greater Mississippi Crossings area. Following the September walking tour, initial existing-conditions analysis, and public feedback, LHB has prepared three conceptual land use plans for the Council's review and feedback. The draft concepts are intended to explore a range of potential redevelopment patterns, multimodal connections, and opportunities for housing and commercial investment. When developing the concepts, the consultants kept in mind the City's main goals of further activating the riverfront, supporting redevelopment, improving circulation and pedestrian amenities, and strengthening the historic and recreational character of the area.

 The consultants from LHB presented the concept plans.

Council Consensus:

- The Council provided consensus direction on preferred concept ideas and potential property acquisitions.
